

Session 1 will begin at 9:45 A.M. in the auditorium.



Conference Information

The Conference program is open to all faculty in higher education from 9:45 A.M. - 2:00 P.M. There is no charge to attend the Conference presentations; however, all attendees must register with Lee Maltby. The General Membership meeting and election is open to all current members of the AAUP.

Public transportation - Take the Chicago CTA Red line to the Argyle station, then walk west on Argyle street 2 blocks to the campus at 1345 Argyle Street. Note that you will need to walk a little south on Broadway to continue walking west on Argyle as shown on the map.

Buses run on Clark, Broadway, Lawrence, and Foster; and a Metra Station is less than 1 mile away from St. Augustine.

Free parking is available in the St. Augustine parking lot, and on nearby streets.

Lunch is on your own. There are number of restaurants along Broadway Avenue and Argyle.
